Topic: Discussion and possible action on Resolution #2025-06, Fees Resolution,

proposing fee adjustments for implementation January 1, 2026

## Background

Resolution #2020-01 was approved in March 2020 and established Village fees for zoning and planning, building permits, licensing and alcohol related fees, cigarette fees, direct sellers permits, second hand sellers permits, animal related fees, parks/recreation fees, police department fees, public works department fees, erosion control and stormwater management fees, and miscellaneous other fees.

Staff recommends that the Village Administration and Board review fees annually, and adopt an annual resolution to set forth fees for the coming year.

# **Analysis**

Wis. Stat. § 66.0628 states that any fee imposed by a political subdivision (the Village) shall bear a reasonable relationship to the service for which the fee is imposed. In other words, fees are established to recover costs, not to earn profit. Resolution #2025-06 proposes fee adjustments to be effective January 1, 2026 for the 2026 calendar year.

- Planning and zoning fees the proposed adjustments reflect changes that have been implemented previously, but were not approved by resolution.
- Animal related fees most of these fees are established by Dane County, and therefore the Village is simply updating fees to align with the County-imposed fees.
- Parks/Recreation fees the proposed adjustments have been reviewed and recommended for approval by the Parks Committee by a vote of 4 1.
- Public Works fees staff proposes minor increases to certain fees to reflect increasing costs of services since fees were last reviewed.
- Sanitation fees proposed to align with the Village's approved contract for 2026.

Staff recommends that in the future, the fee schedule is simplified to refer to fees that are established by the State of Wisconsin or Dane County, and not set by the Village.
